Enrollment Process

- Parents visit school.
- Submit enrollment application along with a copy of up-to-date Immunization record, Student Record Release form, last report card, transcript and birth certificate. (\$25 Application Fee)
- Parents request that student's pastor send a letter of recommendation.
- Office will then call for an initial family interview (both parents, pupil & siblings).
- Student takes Diagnostic test for accurate placement. (\$15 Testing fee)
- A second interview will be scheduled to discuss test results and placement.
- Parents will be notified of acceptance.
- Parents attend Parent Orientation.

PAYMENT OPTIONS (Check one)

- Full Payment in Advance.** Entire payment must be paid by 1st day of school for the coming school year.
- Ten Month Payment Plan.** Ten payments begin on the 1st day of school and must be paid on the 1st of each month for 10 months (through May 1st). Monthly payments are due by the 1st of each month. Unpaid balances will be assessed a \$15 late fee on the 5th of each month.

WITHDRAWAL PROCESS

If monthly tuition & late fee are not paid in full by the end of the month, the student will be considered withdrawn by administration unless arrangements have been made by the finance committee through the administrator.

In the case a student is withdrawn any time after the 1st day of the school year, tuition, if paid, will be refunded for the months not yet entered. *Example: A student is withdrawn in the 1st week of December, any tuition paid for the months of January through May will be refunded. Full monthly tuition installment for the month of December will be due if not already paid. Application, Diagnostic Testing, Athletics, Registration & Book fees are all non-refundable*

Please note that refunds, (if any), can take up to 30 business days to be processed and issued. No school records will be released to the parents/guardians until the withdrawal process has been completed, the financial account fulfilled, and any balances satisfied.

ACE STUDENT CONVENTIONS

Students, supervised by SFJMCS staff, spend 4 to 5 days at Mt. Lebanon Baptist Encampment in Cedar Hill, TX, competing against students from other ACE schools in the Southern Plains region. Students compete in individual and group events in the categories of Academics, Music, Art, Platform & Athletics.

Jr. Convention – 1st week of November, Tuesday thru Friday (ages 9-12)

1. Each student can only enter fifteen total events. (not including open events)
2. Each student can only enter four elimination events.
3. Each student can enter only 9 performance events.
4. All students will be required to enter at least one event in the Academic category.

Regional Convention – 1st week of April, Monday thru Friday(ages 13-18)

(Participation is required for all able-bodied students.)

1. A student may compete in 8 performance events.
2. A student may enter 3 elimination events.
3. A student may enter 4 athletic events.
4. Students who participate in any athletic events must enter at least two nonathletic events.
5. The total combined number of performance and nonperformance events must not exceed 12.
6. All students will be required to enter at least one event in the Academic category.

International Student Convention – Dates in May 2023 TBD

Students go on to compete on an International level in events in which they've placed in the top 6 at Regional Convention.
